Dr. Carrillo obtained his M.D. from the Pontificia Universidad Javeriana, in Bogotá-Colombia. Completed his OBGYN residency at Rochester General Hospital (Rochester, NY). After this completed a Fellowship in Minimally Invasive Gynecologic Surgery (MIGS) through the American Association of Gynecologic Laparoscopists (AAGL) at the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry. This Fellowship had an emphasis in chronic pelvic pain (CPP). Currently is part of the Orlando VA Healthcare System (as CPP specialist and MIGS), is an Associate Professor of OBGYN for the University of Central Florida, serves as faculty for the Orlando VA FMIGS and is the Site Director for the UCF/HCA OBGYN Residency Program. He is completing his second year of a Master's for the Health Professions Education (University of Maastricht- Netherlands).
